RWI sessions will reinforce sounds and spelling rules.

We will complete our TRAWL (Teaching Reading and Writing Links) project and then move on to Non- fiction writing relating to our work on Italy and our baby chicks.



PSHE- Respecting Differences and Human Rights.



We will be covering money -adding and subtracting pounds and pence and giving change. Next we will move on to statistics; looking at tally charts, pictograms and bar charts. We will also begin work around length and perimeter.



Geography- We will complete our History work on the Romans and then move onto exploring the human and physical geography of Italy. We will find out about famous landmarks and Italian culture.

Science - Plants.
