









<p>English</p> <p>RWI comprehension sessions will develop vocabulary, inference and retrieval skills.</p> <p>Our text this term will be The Minpins. We will be using it to pick out grammatical features and develop our dictionary and thesaurus skills. We will also use it to write descriptions, letters and instructions.</p> <p>We will then use the short film, “Soar” as a prompt for writing playscripts.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be recapping identifying half, quarters and thirds of shapes and amounts.</p> <p>We will then go on to look at tenths. Finally we will work on telling the time to the nearest minute and using the 24 hour clock.</p> 	<p>Science- Living Things and their habitats.</p> <p>We will recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways, explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment, recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>We will be basing our work around the Abba song, Mamma Mia; singing it, playing it on an instrument and using it to help us compose.</p> 
<p>PSHE- Economic Wellbeing</p> <p>Considering spending decisions; learning about how to create a budget; recognising that money affects how we feel and how we feel when money is lost.</p> 	<p>History and Geography We will be learning about the history and geography of Greenhaugh and Bellingham, discovering how the area has changed over time and how its geographical location has contributed to its history.</p>	 <p>RE – We will be finding out about the importance of Eid-ul-Fitr and Eid-ul-Adha for Muslims.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>We will be using J2Code and Scratch to develop our programming skills.</p>
